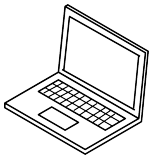
## Winter 2019 Extended Day Activities

### Monday – Creative Computing



Morningside welcomes back Computing Kids for “Creative Computing with Scratch 202.” Students will follow their interests and use their foundational skills to create more sophisticated projects and games. They will be introduced to a variety of advanced gaming and animation techniques and provide individualized support as they take on new challenges like modeling with mathematical equations and Boolean logic. Students will have the opportunity to learn and implement gravity and scrolling backgrounds to build platformer games similar to Super Mario Bros. Students are not required to have taken Scratch 101 with us this fall, but they should know the basics of the Scratch program.

### Tuesday – Indoor Interactive Games

End your school day with fun indoor activities! Students will join our Wushu instructor Rusty (“Sifu”) each week to explore a wide variety of indoor games, including Paracord projects (making bracelets, decorative knots, etc.), Origami (paper folding), Kirigami (Japanese paper cutout art), foam fencing tournaments, paper airplane contests, indoor team games, partner card games, “Whose Line Is It Anyway” improv fun, and more! Students will be encouraged to learn new games each week and explore new challenges. This is a great time to develop teamwork, good sportsmanship, and positive interactions with other students.



### Tuesday – Beyblades (half session)

Welcome to Morningside’s first Beyblade Club! During this after-school activity students will learn: the four different Beyblades types and the advantages and disadvantages of each type (Attack, Defense, Stamina and Balance), students will learn to customize their Beyblades to overcome the advantages of competitors, students will learn how to use different parts to create different blades, as well as the basics of launching strategies and techniques. In addition, students will learn the background of Beyblade name origins (for example, some Beyblades are named after constellations and zodiac signs- students will learn the Beyblades that goes with their own zodiac sign). Finally, after learning a short lesson students will have to time to practice their newly learned skills in fun tournaments. As well, students will practice turn-taking during their Beyblade duals. Morningside will provide a few arenas, please bring your own Beyblade toys.



### Wednesday – Magic: The Gathering



Learn the rules and strategies of this exciting card game, or continue on your quest as wizard “planeswalkers”! We will have an ongoing tournament and practice the considerate giving and taking of feedback, creative problem solving, and etiquette through friendly competition. *Students must bring a playable deck*, which can be purchased at most game stores.

### Thursday – Arts & Crafts
