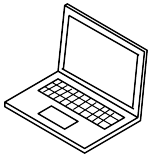
## Spring 2019 Extended Day Activities

Monday, April 15<sup>th</sup> – Thursday, June 13<sup>th</sup>

We offer a great variety of after school activities to Morningside Academy students! **Please review the extended day options below for Monday, April 15<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, June 13<sup>th</sup>. You'll find the program details in the chart on the following page.** Please note that there are not extended day classes during Professional Development days and school closures.

### Monday – App Inventor



Morningside welcomes back Computing Kids for “App Inventor”. Students discover how to build games and solve real-world problems with App Inventor, a visual drag and drop programming language developed by Google. Through creating mobile apps like Finger Paint and Wack-A-Mole, students explore fundamental computer science concepts such as conditional statements, modeling with mathematical equations, and event handling. In the process of developing an original app, they learn about effective user interface and design principals.

### Tuesday (Option 1) – Field Sports

End your school day with an energetic hour of exploring field sports! Join Wushu instructor Rusty for a variety of fun activities. This may include basketball, Frisbee golf, track and field exercises, and more. Be sure to dress in comfortable clothes and bring a water bottle! You could be the next American Ninja Warrior!



### Tuesday (Option 2) – Beyblades (half session)

Welcome to Morningside’s Beyblades Club! During this after-school activity, students will learn: the four different Beyblades types and the advantages and disadvantages of each type (Attack, Defense, Stamina and Balance), students will learn to customize their Beyblades to overcome the advantages of competitors, students will learn how to use different parts to create different blades, as well as the basics of launching strategies and techniques. In addition, students will learn the background of Beyblade name origins (for example, some Beyblades are named after constellations and zodiac signs- students will learn the Beyblades that goes with their own zodiac sign). Finally, after learning a short lesson students will have to time to practice their newly learned skills in fun tournaments. As well, students will practice turn-taking during their Beyblade duals. Morningside will provide a few arenas, please bring your own Beyblade toys.



### Wednesday (Option 1) – Magic: The Gathering

**\*\*NOTE the first two sessions will be indoor table games. Teacher Nick returns the third date to resume Magic class\*\***

Learn the rules and strategies of this exciting card game, or continue on your quest as wizard “planeswalkers”! We will have an ongoing tournament and practice the considerate giving and taking of feedback, creative problem solving, and etiquette through friendly competition.

**Students must bring a playable deck**, which can be purchased at most game stores.



### Wednesday (Option 2) – Sailing (half session BEGINS MAY 8<sup>th</sup>)



The youth sailing programs at The Center for Wooden Boats (CWB) are designed to engender skills in leadership, observation, and decision-making, while offering a chance to connect with nature and Northwest history in a hands-on, physically invigorating way. Students have fun learning the basic theory and terminology of sailing and build a foundation in boating skills.

CWB instructors will meet students at Morningside Academy at 3:00 PM to take the Seattle Street Car to CWB at Lake Union Park. The cost of the transportation is included in the registration fee. **The program end time is 6:00 PM and student pick up is at the pavilion (uplands) at CWB.**
